Program Description

The program includes online clinical specific instruction.

Application Deadline

Students applying for the Fall 2016 program must submit an application to the Limited Entry Office by **July 1, 2016**. Late applications may be considered if space permits. A "Limited-Entry Application for Admission to a Health Science Program" is available online at <http://sites.csn.edu/health/LEapplication.pdf>. Final grades or completed transcript evaluation must be in the Limited Entry Office by **July 1, 2016**.

(Note: Transcript evaluation process takes 8-10 weeks, you must initiate this process at least 10 weeks before the completion deadline)

Accepted Students

Students accepted into the program will be required to show proof of Healthcare Provider CPR certification from the AHA, health insurance, and immunization against Hepatitis B, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella, Tetanus, and Diphtheria. Proof of a negative two-step TB skin test and negative urine drug screen will be required prior to the first scheduled practicum/clinical experience. A physical exam must also be completed. In addition, an official background investigation will also be required.
